Tips & Tricks



What do I need to know about RV generators?

An RV generator provides the electricity to various equipment and appliances within your RV. It feeds the electricity via the circuit breaker panel to these equipment and appliances. It also provides the power to operate your converter/charger, which charges your RV house batteries.



Is it OK to run RV generator all night?

A built-in RV generator in a motorhome can be run all night to power everything in the RV. Just keep the windows closed to prevent any fumes or carbon monoxide from seeping into the interior. A portable generator for a trailer or 5th wheel can run approximately 6 hours before running out of gas.



How long should I run my RV generator each month?

How long should you exercise an RV generator? More is better. Onan, the most popular of all the RV generator manufacturers, recommends two hours a month. During the season, if you are using the RV and firing up the generator from time to time, you want to make sure it runs for a bare minimum of 60 minutes.

***How often should I change the oil in my RV generator?
every 150 hours***

Changing the Oil and Oil Filter

***Service Interval: every year or every 150 hours of run time,
whichever comes first.***





Report: NHTSA Issues its Latest Rundown of RV Recalls

The following is the latest list of RV recalls compiled by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA):

- Triple E Recreational Vehicles is recalling 2,056 2015 Free Spirit, 2015-2018 Unity, 2015-2016 Libero, 2015-2018 Serenity, and Wonder recreational vehicles. Please see attached 573 for a complete list of model numbers. The refrigerator exhaust vents directly onto the wood frame and surfaces, which can overheat the wood.
- Forest River Inc. is recalling 101 2022 Coachmen Catalina travel trailers. The panel that separates the furnace from the cooktop was not sealed, which could result in an inverted cooktop flame.
- Forest River Inc. is recalling 125 2021-2022 XLR Toy Hauler recreational vehicles. The protective panel that separates the furnace and furnace components from the mid-deck cargo area is missing.



Northern Indiana's Supply Chain 'Stretched, Not Broken'

Take a walk through a grocery store and you'll notice product gaps in the aisles and refrigerated cases; visit a car dealership and you'll see more asphalt than inventory; go to a restaurant and you might be told what isn't available, according to a report in the South Bend (Ind.)Tribune.

Such is what happens when an economy rebounds from a pandemic-induced recession a lot faster than expected and demand for goods and services is greater than the supply chain's ability to satisfy those wants, said Michael Hicks, an economist at Ball State University.

"The supply chain isn't broken," Hicks said. "It's mostly just stretched."

Ports have been at near capacity for decades and there's been a shortage of truck drivers needed to move products for quite some time, so it should come as no surprise that nearly every business is coping with shortages to some degree.

Elkhart-area manufacturers have been complaining about the challenging supply issues – and labor shortages – they've been facing for more than a year. And though they're producing RVs and boats at record-breaking levels, most are reporting a backlog of orders extending through much of next year.

"Most Americans continued to work through COVID, and now many of them are spending what they might have saved," Hicks said. "Demand is high for almost everything, but the ability to supply that demand is pretty stressed."

Computer chips have made it impossible for auto manufacturers to keep up with demand for new cars, and higher prices for used cars has now pushed business to repair shops as some consumers are opting to hang onto vehicles a while longer.

But, don't count on quick service there, either.

The need for employees, high demand for services and the possibility of having to locate a part, could result in a wait of several weeks, according to Jay Basney, general manager of Basney Honda in Mishawaka.



SWEET POTATO SOUFFLE

- 2 pounds sweet potatoes, peeled and cubed
- 2 tablespoons butter
- 1/4 cup brown sugar
- 1/4 cup seedless raisins
- 1/8 teaspoon nutmeg
- 1/4 cup evaporated skim milk
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 egg, slightly beaten
- Grated rind and juice of 1/2 lemon
- 2 tablespoons chopped pecans
- 1/2 9-ounce package miniature marshmallows
- 2 tablespoons shredded coconut



Up to 1 week ahead: Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Place sweet potatoes in a large pot with salted water to cover. Bring to boil over high heat. Reduce heat to medium and cook potatoes for 15 minutes or until tender. Remove from heat and drain. Place warm sweet potatoes and butter in a large bowl and whip with an electric mixer. Add brown sugar, raisins, nutmeg, evaporated milk, salt, egg, lemon rind, lemon juice, and chopped pecans. Mix well. Coat a 10-inch round or 9x9-inch baking pan with cooking spray. Transfer sweet potato mixture to baking pan and bake 30 minutes. Cool, cover tightly with plastic wrap, then aluminum foil, and freeze.

1 day ahead: Remove soufflé from freezer and defrost at room temperature. When completely defrosted, place soufflé in refrigerator. Place shredded coconut in a small, nonstick skillet over medium heat and toss until toasted. Remove from heat, cool, and place in a small zip-top bag. Refrigerate.
